

The Cyber Essentials Plus Assist service is a remotely conducted service offering designed to help organisations prepare for the Cyber Essentials Plus Assessment, increasing your chance of passing first time. During the Gap-analysis we will assess your conformance to the Cyber Essentials Standard by performing a basic secure configuration and vulnerability assessment, against a subset of the devices in scope. Following this assessment you will be provided with guidance on what changes may need to be made to achieve certification.

What happens on the day?

A typical Cyber Essentials Plus Assist Gap-analysis will include the following:

Initial Meeting over Skype (or similar service):

- Introductions
- Overview of Cyber Essentials

Introduction to Security Controls:

- Importance of the 5 key security controls
- Overview of Secure Configurations
- Overview of Firewalls
- Overview of User Access Controls
- Overview of Patch Management
- Overview of Malware Protection

Introduction to the Certification Process:

- Overview of the Assessment Process
- Guidance on defining the Scope

Vulnerability Assessment :

- an internal vulnerability assessment on a subset of devices

What Happens Next?

A basic report will be produced highlighting any non-conformances and the necessary actions. It is essential that you address these non-conformances before proceeding to the Cyber Essentials Plus Assessment.
